While incarcerated in the Atlanta federal penitentiary in 1924 for larceny, conspiracy and some 100 violations of the Prohibition Act, Gaston B. Means, a former Harding Administration official and private investigator, met May Dixon Thacker, the sister of novelist Thomas Dixon, whose *The Clansman* (1905) had been transformed by D. W. Griffith into *The Birth of a Nation* for the big screen in 1915. Mrs. Thacker, the author of *True Confessions*, promised to help Means tell his story. After his release, Means spent day after day dictating to her.
