His prose tempered over time and this phase perhaps culminated in *Town Planning*, first published in 1940 and reputed to have sold over 250,000 copies. The aim of *The Anatomy of the Village* was to set out the main principles of village planning, especially in relation to physical design. *Anatomy* became a key text in thinking about villages in the post-war period; a period when there was great concern that settlements should develop in more sensitive ways than inter-war ribbon and suburban development patterns. The problems of poor quality development, unrelated to settlement form, was to continue to stimulate books such as Lionel Brett's *Landscape in Distress* and campaigns from the Architectural

Review. Reading the text today it still has much to offer: while some of its assumptions about the level of services a village might support clearly belong to another era, its beautiful and simple typological analyses of village form continue to be of relevance.
