Together, they set out to prove that Kayla is dead—and to find her before she is. This title has Common Core connections. In this joyful and impactful book, a transgender boy prepares for the first day of school and introduces himself to his family and friends for the first time. Calvin has always been a boy, even if the world sees him as a girl. He knows who he is and in his mind but he hasn't yet told his family. Finally, he can wait no longer: "I'm not a girl," he tells his family. "I'm a boy--a boy in my heart and in my brain." Quick to support him, his loving family takes Calvin shopping for the swim trunks he's always wanted and back-to-school clothes and a new haircut that will look and feel like the boy he's always known himself to be. As the first day of school approaches, he's overwhelmed by the "what-ifs" gather up inside him. But as his friends and teachers rally around him and he tells them about himself, all his "what-ifs" begin to melt away. Inspired by the authors' own transgender child and accompanied by vibrant and triumphant illustrations, this authentic and personal text promotes kindness and empathy, offering an inclusive back-to-school message: all should feel safe, respected, and welcomed. Twins, Kayla and Kyle, are competing against each other to become their schools next class president. Before their friends can cast their votes they must first have a class debate. Find out who will win the election and also learn new adventures along the way. This book edition comes with a glossary in the back to help kids define the vocabulary. When Max starts school, the teacher hesitates to call out the name on the attendance sheet. Something doesn't seem to fit. Max lets her know the name he wants to be called by--a boy's name. This begins Max's journey as he makes new friends and reveals his feelings about his identity to his parents. Written with warmth and insight by trans writer Kyle Lukoff, this book is a sweet and age-appropriate introduction to what it means to be transgender.
